Attributes of a Copyeditor:

- ✓ An eye for detail
- ✓ Confidence using Microsoft Word and familiarity with some of its more advanced functions (changing/applying styles, use of symbols, etc.)
- ✓ Good general chemistry or physics knowledge (most copyeditors are in the process of obtaining or have a postgraduate degree in chemistry, physics and related disciplines)

The role of the Copyeditor includes:

- to ensure that the manuscripts are in clear and precise English (*language polishing*)
- to ensure that the journals have a uniform appearance (*formal adjustments*)
- to check if any part of the science is inconsistent or incorrect (*scientific editing*)
- to create a short text for the Table of Contents (graphical abstract), if not supplied by the author(s)

Our manuscripts vary in length from 6-30 pages. You would be expected to edit on-screen using MS Word and also to check diagrams, figures, schemes and tables against the content of the text. Usually you have about one week to return a manuscript to us. You will be provided with a copyediting guide and various other helpful documents and our editors will provide full training and feedback.
