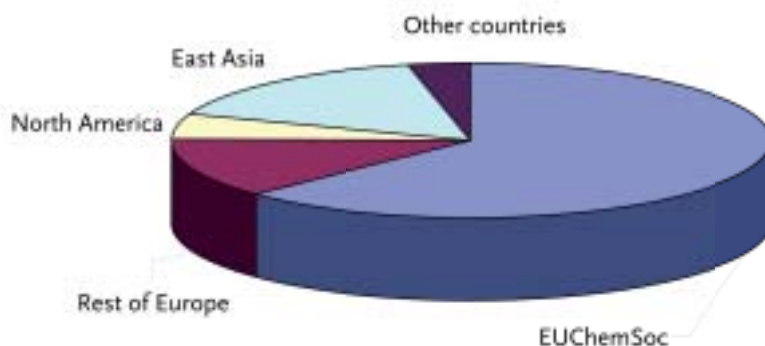

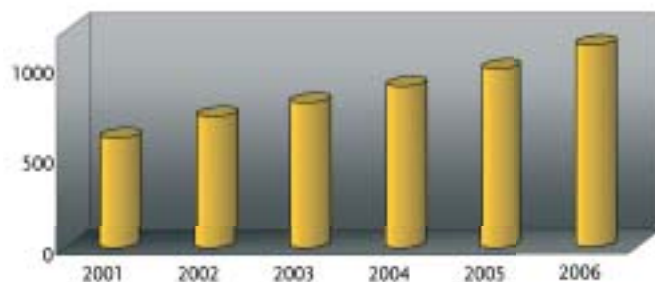


Geographical distribution of published articles 2006
