I am delighted to be able to inform you that at the most recent review meeting the National Library of Medicine (NLM) decided to index PROTEOMICS - Clinical Applications for inclusion in MEDLINE/PubMed. This is excellent news and should prove a major stimulus for the future development of the journal. Clearly the visibility of published papers to the general scientific community as provided by inclusion in MEDLINE/PubMed is a major concern for Authors when considering the appropriate journal to which to submit the results of their research. With this decision by NLM potential Authors can be assured that all future papers that are accepted for publication in PROTEOMICS Clinical Applications will now be promptly added to the MEDLINE/PubMed database. I am also pleased to assure you that all papers that have been published in the first three Volumes of the journal (2007-2009) have now been added retrospectively to MEDLINE/PubMed. This will ensure improved access and visibility to the proteomics community of papers already published in the journal. I now invite all researchers active in the area of biomedical and clinical proteomics to consider submitting their work to PROTEOMICS Clinical Applications, currently the only proteomics journal indexed by MEDLINE that specialises exclusively in this important area.
